Water tracing at Skrimfjell

A successful water tracing with Rhodamine B and Fluorecein using charcoal detectors was done at Skrimfjell in October 1981. Definitive connections were proved from Drinkwater Slocker to K3 and K2, and between Beaver Cave and K2. The possibility for an additional connection directly between Beaver Cave and K1 has not been excluded, although the concentration of dye was higher in the K2- detector than in the K1 one. Pulse- type experiments are necessary to solve this problem further. Tracings between the Sandåa stream and Beaver Cave and from Beaver Gave to K4 were negative.
