### **Dvergsteinholene**

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Dvergsteinholene lie in the steep east slope of Eidsfjell about 1100 m asl. Eidsfjell rises steeply up to 1335 m asl. on the west side of Norefjord in Numedal, about 90 km northwest of Kongsberg. The caves lie in quartzite and are formed by expansion of gas while the rock was molten. The caves are said to have had walls and ceiling covered with quartzite crystals for around 100 years ago. They are all removed now. The caves are from 5 to 15 m long.
