A couple of caves in Midt-Troms

The discoveries during a couple of exploration trips to the Tamokdalen and Takvatn area in Troms. Sketch-survey and description of a cave in Tamokdalen Valley. This was a wet, phreatic cave, with a sink choked by rocks and flood debris. In the area around the lake Takvatn, a local farmer pointed out the entrance to a cave used by Russian refugees during the last war. This was a wet, tight cave. The cave was on a later trip found to end in a sump with a possible by-pass - partially choked by compact clay and pebbles.
