Glomdalen 1984

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A return to the Glomdal valley area to complete previous exploration and studies. From a base at Øvre Pikhaugvatn lake explorations were made along one of the marble bands going north east to south-west in Glomdalen valley. A shaft (1, see map), approx. 20 metres deep, was found in the northern area. Another shaft nearby was descended for about 10 m. In the southern area, a number of shafts were found, one of which could be descended for c 5 m to a meandering stream passage. This ended in a choked termination after more than 100 m. A survey is planned in the future.
