Fra Tysfjordens ukjente grotteverden

Exploring a "new" cave area in Tysfjord

An expedition consisting of 6 Norwegian cavers, led by Stein Erik Lauritzen explored a limestone area 400 by 30 m in Sørfjorden, a branch of Tysfjorden in Troms county. Two British members of the filmteam shooting the dive trough the Glomdalvann outlet also participated.

During 1 week, 4 large shafts up to 50 m deep leeding down to a vast system of passages with a total length of about 2000 m was explored and surveyed.

Glyn Bolt and David St Pierre explored limestone areas on the west side of Botnelvdal canyon without making any discoveries.
