Diving in "Kilde 2" in the Skrim area

1984 was the year the Norwegian cave divers decided to explore caves instead of shipwrecks. The cave they chose to start with, was "Kilde 2" (Ive and Wilkinson 1981) at Skrim, a promising looking report for divers.

The first day Ronny Arnesen dived as far into the cave as the English divers had come, about 20 m. Dag Grepperud extended the dive with 10 m and found that the cave was divided in 2 passages about 27 m from the entrance. During the summer Ronny Arnesen, Dag Grepperud and Stein Johnsen dived as far into the cave as 55 m, which they decided was their limit, based on their experience as cave divers. Through this diving period they had made many useful experiences and had tried what psychial stress can do to a person. An instructive period was over and they decided to dive as far into the cave as 100 metres the following year.
