TROMS 88 I

A group of 11 Tjech cavers from the QRCUS club of Ostrava visited Northern Norway and Sweden in August 1988. ORCUS members travel abroad once or twice a year despite tight budgets. Guides were at first Rabbe Sjøberg and wife Ljuba who took the party to see some sea caves and Kristihola near Fauske.
