

**Rapport fra grotteredningskonferanse i Buxton, England 16.-18.06.00**

Report of a cave rescue conference in Derbyshire, England.

The themes discussed included the use of dynamite, decompression sickness (bends), recent rescue situations in France, dam building, radio in caves and the question of whether or not cave rescue organizations should take on other rescue tasks, e.g. from collapsed houses after earthquakes. The conclusion was, not as an organization, but organizations could give advice and support volunteers.
