Krubera Cave - verdens dypeste grotte

The Krubera cave - the deepest in the world.

The cave is situated in the Arabika mountains in western Kaukasus in Georgia. The opening is at 2240 m. In January 2001 Ukranian cavers recorded a depth of 1710 m, 80 m more than the no. 2 on the list. It may be possible to reach an even greater depth of the cave, perhaps beyond 2000 m.
