Tur til Tjoarvekrajgge 1.-3. november 2002

Trip to Tjoarvekrajgge 1-3 November 2002.

A team of three cavers hoped to break the existing surveying record of 81 sights in one day. Two nights were spent at the campsite in the cave. The batteries to both the clinometer and compass turned out to be bad, necessitating extra light. A Maglite was available, but had to be held at a distance from the instruments due to magnetism. A triumph was the discovery of a new connection between two different parts of the cave. A hope of discovering a new exit was frustrated by a collapse. A new passage was explored as far as the Tjorve rules permit without surveying. 319 meters were surveyed, distributed on 46 sights. A new attempt may be made in 2003.
