Review of the book "Redningsdykking"

This book, written by Ronny Arnesen, consists of 260 pages divided into 17 chapters concerning aspects of rescue diving (not in caves), and one chapter about surface rescue in lakes/ivers with ice. The book is for rescue divers. But, in addition to facts about technicalities, he deals a lot with principles that also can be used by any rescue service, like NGRT or Red Cross. Since Ronny is a professional rescue diver, he has described a lot of self-experienced rescue stories. These stories are interesting and exiting to read for nearly everybody.
