The cave passes under the road to Kalvatnet in Plurdalen and has several entrances. After the building of the power plant in the 60's the water flow is very reduced. Until today the water has been back on only one occasion, but it is possible that it happens again. In that case there will be a flood in the cave without any warning.

The main entrance lies in a doline south of Sprutforsen. A through trip requires SRT and wetsuit is recommended. To go by the cliff at Sprutforsen, a 30 m rope is needed. Be aware of lose trees when belying. The entrance named Hatcham hole is found between the main entrance and Sprutforsen, a little to the west. The passage is a narrow meander.
