Huler nær Stokksund i Åfjord, Sør-Trøndelag

References to caves near Stokksund in Åfjord, Sør-Trøndelag

References to 11 former sea caves or tectonic features in granite and gneiss in the Stokksund area have been extracted from the "Norwegian Cave Index and Bibliography."

The "best known" is Harbakhulen, 97 moh, l c. 200 m. The earliest reference quoted is O. Krefting, 1865. His plan of "Horbakhulen" is reproduced. A comparison is made between his drawing of the entrance and a recent photo by Trond Rian who illustrates several of the other caves.
