Caves at Leka, nord-Trondelag

Twelve caves are listed in Leka kommune (population c.550), on the west coast of central Norway 65° north, close tothe boundary with Nordland Fylke. They are brenningsgrotter formed by the sea when theland was depressed. Granitic rocks occupy the greatest area. Several of the caves are of archaeological importance (SeeSognes, 1983) containing cave paintings by hunter-gatherersor agrarians of the Stone Age, which are illustrated. Fingalshula Solsemhula can only be visited with a guide.
