### **Tektonisk grotte i Bergen**

A tectonic cave in Bergen?

The Norwegian geologist and naturalist Hans H. Reusch described in 1882 the so-called "Nils Klíms" cave in Bergen, a small fissure cave formed in quartzitic schist. The cave may be of a tectonic origin. The name of the cave is taken from the famous Danish writer Ludvig Holberg, telling about Nils Klíms journey into a subterranean world. The question is whether this cave still exists, as it may have collapsed, or buried during the elapsed time and the expansion of the town. The cave was also called "Mareminehullet".
