Jutulstuggu is a rather special cave near the farm Hellem in Levanger. The mountain has elements of limestone with conglomeration but its origin is not based on the work of water. The entrance lies halfway up the rather steep hillside, and it is turned towards east. The cave is some sort of "crack-cave", but forms a rather complex structure with partly rather big dimensions. Two steep demands ropes before you can enter the bottom level.
